



HOME RESTAURANT COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

(Condensed version for display)

Maximum Guest Occupancy as of May 21st, 2020 – 60 guests

No groups of people larger than 6 may be seated together

Tables are pre-assigned to ensure proper social distancing in accordance with current standards.

Maximum Washroom occupancy – 2 guests

Face masks & gloves are available to all staff. Face masks are required of any staff member who is close contact with guests (servers, hosts, managers). Gloves are required for all cleaning duties and clearing of dirty dishes from tables.

Hand sanitizer is available for staff and guests. You can find dispensers at the front door, back door, and by the washrooms. Back-up sanitizers are available if needed.

Guests are expected to help adhere to current social distancing guidelines and certain measures have been taken through the restaurant to help instruct and direct people through those expectations.

Plexiglass has been installed had the front host stand for greeting guests. Chairs have been moved out of the waiting area, as guests will be required to line up outside the building when there is no tables available.

Service staff may approach a table to take orders and to deliver food and beverage to guests. Service staff cannot reach over guests to deliver plates, and the expectation will be to drop food and beverages at the edge of the table and the guests can distribute amongst themselves.

All tables, seats, and table condiments will be properly cleaned and sanitized between each seating. All common touch areas such as doors, faucets, etc. will be cleaned and sanitized throughout the day and disinfected twice daily.

Takeout options will include pre-ordering by phone, curbside pickup, and 3rd party delivery. All of which should help maintain distancing protocols.

All common touch areas in the kitchen such as doors, faucets, handles, fridges, etc. will be cleaned and sanitized throughout the day and disinfected twice daily. Kitchen staff will not share smallware items such as knives and tongs.

Staff will stagger breaks, and will avoid any unnecessary chatting in groups or lingering before or after their shift.

Staff has been instructed to stay home if presenting any signs of illness, and must remain at home until they are symptom free for at least 24 hours.

In the event of a positive COVID-19 result for an employee, that employee is to stay away from work and Public Health needs to be notified immediately. All employees that had contact with that employee will be expected to self-isolate and seek medical advice.
